

Toyota Tacoma/Tundra differential drop kit instructions



- 1. Remove the skid plate from the bottom of the truck.
- 2. Using a floor jack support the differential.
- 3. Remove the factory M14 bolts. Make sure you save the OEM dome washers.
- 4. Lower the differential far enough to insert the drop spacers. The differential may need to be pulled down to make enough room.
- 5. reinstall the differential using the new longer supplied bolts and nuts.
- 6. Reinstall the skid plate using the small new skid plate drop spacers and the new longer hardware.
- 7. Make sure to recheck the torque of all bolts once done.
